Superhero Fun Run Crawley 2017

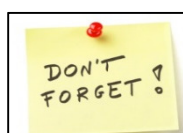

School Uniform

Please could we ask all parents to check their child's school uniform over the summer holidays to ensure they comply with the Uniform Policy.
